COSTUME CARE REMINDERS

- Please do not let your dancer play or eat in their costume prior to our recital on May 31st. This way your dancer's costume will not get damaged or dirty.
- Please store your dancer's costume in a closet where it can hang freely. Please do not fold it or store it in a bag as this can severely wrinkle and damage the costume.
- If your dancer's costume is wrinkly, we recommend placing it in the shower while taking a hot shower and this will safely release the wrinkles. **DO NOT** place your child's costume in the dryer as it will damage the costume.
- For dancers with more than 1 costume we highly recommend investing in a garment bag to house all costume items. This prevents items from being lost, damaged or forgotten.
- Also please make a note if your dancer needs to provide their own items as part of a costume (black leotard, black tights, etc.) so that these items are not forgotten.
