The South Dayton School of Dance is committed to providing the highest quality classical dance education by boasting a faculty of which each member has either a college degree in dance, professional dance experience, or both. SDSD prides itself on creating a family atmosphere where all feel welcome to fall in love with the joy of dance.

STUDENT & PARENT BEHAVIOR POLICIES

Email/Text Communication: Email is our primary means of communication with parents. Our official email address is southdaytonschoolofdance@gmail.com. Please check your email often for new information and updates from SDSD. If you are not receiving our emails, please check your spam or junk folder first, and then email us if the issue persists. Additionally, we send a monthly newsletter with an abbreviated schedule, reminders, and information about upcoming events, and more! Texts will only be sent for very important reminders or in emergency situations.

Attendance and Promptness: Attendance will be monitored closely. Absenteeism will slow down your child's progress as well as the progress of the entire class. We are committed to developing your child's talents to their fullest potential; therefore, attendance is expected at each scheduled class. Part of a student's attendance includes being on time. Dance students are expected to arrive 5-10 minutes prior to class. If a student arrives more than 10 minutes after the start of the class, the instructor will have her/him sit, observe, and not participate for their own safety as they will have missed the warmup. Recital participation requires consistent attendance and is up to the discretion of the teacher.

Student Absence Policy/Make-Up Classes: If your dancer will be absent from a class, we ask that you enter this absence into our Parent Portal so that our instructors can plan accordingly. Make-up classes are available only if the dancer is ill or if there is a family emergency. Make-up classes are not permitted for absences resulting from participation in other activities. If you will miss a class due to illness or emergency, you must schedule your makeup class on the Parent Portal. All missed classes must be made-up within 1 month of the class missed.

Behavior Standards: South Dayton School of Dance strives to protect and foster the interests of all dancers and their families at all times. SDSD dancers and their parents/guardians are expected to behave in a socially acceptable fashion and in furtherance of the wellbeing of all dancers, faculty, staff, guests, partners and volunteers. South Dayton School of Dance has adopted a strict policy against harassment of any kind. Statements made in any form: verbal, written or electronic, and/or behavior that are of racial, ethnic, sexual, violent, threatening, harassing, bullying or demeaning in nature will not be tolerated.





TUITION POLICIES

- The SDSD school year consists of 32 classes.
- There is a \$40 registration fee per student.
- For your convenience, your overall yearly tuition cost is divided into a 9-month payment plan of equal monthly installments.
- Tuition installment payments are due on the 1st of each month.
 - If your account still has an active balance as of the 2nd your payment will be processed automatically to your card on file.
 - If your payment is later than the 2nd for any reason or your card on file is declined a \$25 penalty fee will be added to your account and your dancer will not be permitted to participate in classes until your balance is paid in full.
- Our preferred method of payment is card via our Parent Portal, however we also accept payment in the form of cash or check (made out to SDSD).
 - Cash or check payments must be received by close on the 1st to prevent your card on file from being charged.
- Statements are only emailed if your account is delinquent.

Refunds/Early Withdrawal Policy:

- No refunds will be given for pre-paid tuition.
- In the unlikely event that a student needs to withdraw early, the student will need to drop the class by notifying us in writing by email or through our parent portal.
 - This must be completed to close the account and thus, prevent further billing. If you do not notify us, your account will continue to be charged each month.
- A student's absenteeism does not affect tuition payments.

Tuition Discounts:

- Tuition Discounts cannot be combined.
- The greater discount will be used on each family account.

1._Family/Multi-Class Discounts:

- 4 classes per week = 5% discount
- 5 classes per week = 10% discount
- 6 classes per week = 15% discount
- 7+ classes per week = 20% discount
- 2. **Payment in Full Discount:** Receive 5% off payment of full-year when paid at time of registration.
 - Recital & Class Fees must be included at time of payment.
 - Recital, Class, and registration fees are not discounted.

BUILDING POLICIES

Drop Off/Pick Up/Parking Lot Policies:

- Dancers should be dropped off for class no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the start of their class and should be picked up no later than 5 minutes following the conclusion of their class.
- Parents are not permitted to stay in the drop-off/pick-up area during their child's class. Parents are welcome to wait in our parking lot or to explore the shopping center. We will call you if any issues arise.
- For safety reasons, students will not be permitted to enter or exit the building unattended.
- Parents must park and come into the studio to the drop-off/pickup point to pick up their children.
- For the safety of our students, please do not illegally park your vehicle in the fire lane, or directly in front of our entrance.
- Parking Lot Dress Code: All Students are required to wear street clothes over their dance attire when entering or exiting the school.
 - Please do not allow your child to wear his/her dance shoes outside on the pavement. Imbedded rocks, pebbles, sand and dirt are very hard on our professional marley dance floors.

Classroom Policies:

- Students will bring all belongings including dance bags, shoes, coats, etc. into the studio with them.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the classroom to help their students with shoes, coats, etc. This must be done in the Dropoff/Pick-up area.
- During class all personal items including shoes, clothes, electronics, etc. must be stored in a closed bag against the wall.
- All electronic devices must be on silent and stowed away during class time.
- Please do not allow your child to bring toys or other unnecessary items to the studio. We are not responsible for the security of these items and they are a distraction to your dancer as well as others.

Dancer Lounge Policies:

- Dancers age 9 and older who have 2 or more classes on a given day are permitted to use our Dancer Lounge to eat and do homework.
- Parents are not permitted in the Dancer Lounge
- Dancers are required to clean up after themselves and make sure that all trash ends up in the trash can.
- Dancers must leave the Dancer lounge exactly the way that they found it
- This means putting benches, tables, etc. back to their original location
- Dancers are NOT supervised by an adult while using the Dancer Lounge. Use of the lounge is at the risk of the student and parent.

DRESS & HAIR CODE

- The established dress and hair codes will be strictly enforced.
- Students not meeting the specified attire and hair dress codes will be asked to sit and watch class until dress and hair codes have been met.
- Uniforms create a structured, disciplined class environment, and have a positive
 effect on a student's attitude in class.
- Most professional & pre-professional organizations do require uniforms for dance classes.
- Uniforms reflect quality training & atmosphere and help to instill school pride.
- Teachers need to see a student's body in order to help with proper body alignment.

Hair Code:

- All Female Dancers:
 - High Ballet Bun secured with a hair tie, at least 4 bobby/hair pins, and a hairnet.
- All Male Dancers
 - Hair should be kept out of the face at all times.

Dress Code:

- All items in our Dress Code are required for students.
- All required items are made by Eurotard Dancewear may be purchased online via the QR code below or locally at Got Dance?
 - We highly encourage you to call this store before going as they change their hours often and sometimes without notice (937) 438-1111.
- Age appropriate styles have been selected for best comfort and longest wear.
- Quality dancewear and shoes make a substantial difference in a dancer's performance.
 - While it may seem tempting to purchase dancewear at Target or other department stores, these items are not designed for classical dance training.





OTHER POLICIES

Weather Closing Policy: In the event of inclement weather or poor road conditions, classes may be cancelled for the safety of our students and faculty. When Centerville City Schools are closed due to the weather, SDSD will also be closed. Please check your email for a notification of closure and also our social media accounts will be updated. A text may also be sent to your primary contact phone number. Students may schedule a make-up class for classes cancelled due to weather, which must be used within one month of the missed class date. SDSD does not credit, refund, or pro-rate tuition for classes cancelled due to poor weather.

New Students: Students new to SDSD, with previous training, are required to participate in a short, 10 minute placement class prior to registration to ensure the best and most appropriate placement. Please email or call to schedule an appointment for a placement class.

Recital Policies: SDSD hosts a year-end recital at the end of every school year. This year, our Recital will take place on May 31st, 2025 with a mandatory dress rehearsal on May 30th, 2025.

- Fees associated with our year end recital are due with your 3rd installment payment which is due on or before November 1st.
 - The Recital fee is a flat \$50 fee per student.
 - Class fees vary based on level:
 - This fee covers, costume, choreography, and rehearsal time
 - Dancers in our Pre-Levels (Creative Movement 1 & 2, Pre-Ballet 1 & 2, Pre-Tap 1 & 2, Pre-Jazz) will purchase their costume for a class fee of \$65 per class.
 - Dancers in our Level 1 classes and above rent their costumes from our costume closet which is included in a class fee of \$15 per class
 - Costumes that are rented must be returned directly following your dancer's performance.
- Participation in our Recital is optional however we ask that you let us know regarding your participation by November 1st when Recital Fees are due.
