

# DRESSING ROOM GUIDE

## PINK DRESSING ROOM

- For the Pink Show, all dancers use the “Pink” dressing/holding room.
  - We ask that dancers come with their hair and makeup already done and already in their costume as much as is able. With so many dancers in this show, there is not enough room for all dancers to dress and do hair/makeup on location.
  - Parents must check their dancers in with Miss Noelle as the dancer enters the dressing/holding room. Once checked in, dancers are not permitted to leave the dressing/holding room until the conclusion of the show.
  - Please do not send your dancers with snacks, toys, or anything messy. We have over 30 teenagers whose sole job is to entertain your children while they wait. This also contributes to lost or damaged items which we want to avoid.
  - If your dancer has more than one costume during the Pink Show, you have the choice of helping your dancer change or your dancers demonstrator can help them so that you can continue to enjoy the show!
  - Female parents only will be permitted in the dressing/holding area and only to help dancers change. Parents are not permitted to wait in the dressing/holding area during the show.
